“Love Untold” by Ruth Jones

All agreed that this was an easy read, and although the characters were interesting some felt that the book lacked depth. The style of the book is warm and humorous, with many comic scenes and characters, particularly the divorce lawyer who gave great entertainment but wasn't very authentic.
